In this role, you will report to the Corporate Affairs & Communications Operations Lead Manager based in Cologne and work closely with cross-functional teams in Berlin, Cologne and Trier as well as international colleagues to support strategic initiatives and stakeholder engagement.

Your tasks – exciting and diverse:

- Regulatory Monitoring and Engagement Reduced Risk Products: Track and analyze legislative, regulatory, and taxation developments related to Reduced Risk Products (RRPs), including heated tobacco, nicotine pouches, ecigarettes, and emerging nicotine delivery systems. Collaborate with CA&C and other departments to assess the impact of these developments on JTI's business and the broader tobacco industry.
- Corporate Affairs Support in Berlin: Build and maintain relationships with key stakeholders in national and regional government bodies and support engagement in industry issues such as taxation, regulation and sustainability. Support the development and execution of government relations, media engagement, and corporate event strategies to foster constructive dialogue with stakeholders.
